Meghalay a Krishak Samaj

Enrolment of new members is progressing steadily. The office

For administrative convenience and effective working, Area Units are being formed and formation of such units is now in progress.

Two members of the forum participated in the Special course for the training rural youth and young farmers organised by the All India Cooperative Educational Instructors Training Centre, New Delhi in July-August 1971.

The Samaj is carrying on the propaganda 'GROW MORE FOOD CROPS'. Under this scheme, the Samaj distributed improved varieties of seeds to the farmers. Demo-

nstration of Hybrid Cotton-4 was taken at three places. Arranged a Seminar of Hybrid Cotton-4 on 28-5-1971 which was attended by experts of the Agril. Dept and agricultural Universities and a large number of farmers from various parts of the State. The condition of Kharif crops is not so good for want of proper rains.
